A perpetual trophy and an award of \$600.00, both donated by Idwall Richards and family in memory of J.J. Richards, a prominent Tweed citizen.. Rotary Club of Mt Warning AM Runner Up Award: \$100.00. A minimum of five competitors is required for this section.

3. J.J. RICHARDS MEMORIAL SCHOLARSHIP: DANCE Presented at the performance.

A perpetual trophy and an award of \$1000, both donated by Idwall Richards and family in memory of J.J. Richards, a prominent Tweed citizen.

4. G.H.STAINLAY MEMORIAL SCHOLARSHIP: MUSIC

An award of \$750 with a perpetual trophy and Medallion donated by the Stainlay family, in memory of their father, the late George Herbert Stainlay (Foundation President of the Murwillumbah Musical Festival Society in 1923), for the Music Sections of the Festival. Runner Up Award of \$250.
