Karen Walmsley is an accomplished performer, music educator and guest clinician. She has successfully taught singing for many years, with numerous students having been accepted to study at the Sydney and Melbourne Conservatoriums, Opera Queensland, Opera Australia's Young Artist Programmes, NIDA, WAAPA, and more recently Glyndebourne Opera Chorus, or taken up professional careers in Musical Theatre.

Karen has studied in Australia with Raymond Myers, Ghillian Sullivan, and Irene Waugh, and with the late Vida Harford in England. As a young soprano, Karen won the Dame Nellie Melba Perpetual Trophy at the City of Sydney Eisteddfod, and was a NSW National Finalist in Opera Foundation's Wenkardt Competition.

Opera Australia highlights include performances in internationally acclaimed Baz Luhrmann productions of *La Boheme* (1991 & 1993), simulcast on ABCTV and throughout the UK and USA, and Andrew Sinclair's award-winning *La Traviata*. As well, she performed in Cameron Macintosh's Sydney production of Lloyd Webber's *The Phantom of the Opera* (1994-95), understudying the roles of Madame Giry and Carlotta.

In 2000, Karen sang with the Sydney Symphony Orchestra in its performance of Wagner's *Götterdämmerung* as part of the Olympic Arts Festival, and also performed backing vocals for Michael Crawford's national tour. In Music Theatre, Karen sang the role of Alice in Martin Wesley-Smith's *Boojum!*. Doreen in George Dreyfus's *The Sentimental Bloke*, and was cast as Beatrice in Nick Enright's *The Venetian Twins*. She also played Lady Beaconsfield in the Gold Coast Arts Centre (Australian Premiere) production of *Jekyll and Hyde* in 2004, starring Rob Guest.

Among her concert works are *Messiah, Samson* and *Saul* (Handel), *Dixit Dominus* (Handel), *Christ on the Mount of Olives* (Beethoven), *Mass in C* (Beethoven), *Requiem*

(Mozart), The Good Samaritan (Butterley), Gloria (Vivaldi) and Gloria (Poulenc).

Her substantial operatic performances include the roles of Konstanze (*The Abduction from the Seraglio*), Susanna (*The Marriage of Figaro*), Countess Almaviva (*The Marriage of Figaro*), First Lady (*The Magic Flute*), Mlle Silberklang (*The Impresario*), Mme Euterpova (*Help! Help! The Globolinks*), Rowan (*Let's Make an Opera*), Adele (*Die Fledermaus*), Miss Pinkerton (*The Old Maid and the Thief*), and Mercedes (*Carmen*).

Throughout her career, Karen has taught in government and independent schools. In the Hunter, she was appointed Regional Choral Consultant, and most recently has taught at The Southport School (Director of Music – Preparatory School) and The King's School (Head of Vocal Studies). She has adjudicated at eisteddfodau in New South Wales and Queensland.

Barry Walmsley, MMus, BEd, DSCM, AMusA, ATCL, LTCL, LGSMD, MACE, MACEL, FAIM, Hon TCL

Having been schooled in Murwillumbah, **Barry Walmsley** has enjoyed a multi-faceted career as a music educator, arts journalist, pianist, vocal coach, and adjudicator.

At the Sydney Conservatorium, he studied for the DSCM in piano with Eunice Gardiner and Gordon Watson, as well as organ with Robert Ampt at Sydney, and Sharon Raschke at Newcastle. He went on to add a music education degree after this, as well as the Associate and Licentiate diplomas from a variety of examining bodies (AMEB, Trinity College London, Guildhall School of Music & Drama).



In the mid-80's, Barry took up a part-

time lecturing position, teaching harmony, piano and curriculum studies to undergraduate students. During this time, he toured regional NSW, New Zealand and the United States as a choir accompanist.

For 11 years since 1990, Barry worked for Fairfax Media, as music critic for The Newcastle Herald, writing a regular column each week, as well as reviewing new books and CDs. He currently writes for The Studio magazine (MTA of NSW).

His school teaching career has seen him in the positions of Director of Music at The Southport School and The King's School, Parramatta. Barry teaches piano and theory from his Gold Coast studio as well as mentoring studio teachers undertaking diploma-level training. In addition, he teaches Musicology and Aural Skills in the Orchestral Musicianship (Stage 6 Music 2 course) online course for the Sydney Youth Orchestras. He is a past President of the Music Teachers' Association of NSW, and currently is a Council member of The Australian Society of Musicology and Composition.
