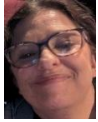
As a committee, we are also grateful for the willing band of people who help us during this time, selling tickets, announcing sections, manning the door and keeping nervous competitors calm backstage.

## **GENERAL FESTIVAL REGULATIONS**

### **GENERAL MANAGEMENT**

In these regulations, the word 'Committee', shall mean the Committee of the Murwillumbah Festival of Performing Arts.

The Committee reserves the right to refuse any entry.

Programming positions will be strictly observed.

In OWN CHOICE competitions, marks will be awarded for quality of selections.

### **BREACH OF REGULATION**

Any competitor deemed to be in breach of a section's regulations will be furnished with an Adjudicator's Report containing comments only.

### **COMPETITIONS**

No competitor will be allowed to perform the same item in more than one section, unless otherwise stated.

Due to time commitments or unnecessary repetition, the Adjudicator may 'ring off' a competitor before completion of the performance. This does not necessarily signify disapproval or rejection. All competitors in Championship Sections must enter and perform in their corresponding age or open sections. (Restricted sections not accepted.)

Please keep Props to a MINIMUM and be sure they are able to be handled by the stage hands. All props to be removed from the precincts of the stage at the conclusion of each session. Persons required to manipulate props or to play music will be allowed in the stage wings, but only during the relative performance.

Sections may be split or combined if warranted, at the discretion of the convener.

The competition is open to amateurs only, not professionals or teachers. (A professional is defined as a person who earns a major part of his/her income from the practice of the art, or who uses the art as a primary means of livelihood.)

Persons with disabilities are encouraged to enter the competitions. Please advise on your Entry Form if wheelchair access to the stage is required.

### **AGE**

Age for competitors is the ACTUAL AGE at Entry Closing Date

### **TIME LIMITS**

Time limits have been specified throughout this schedule. In fairness to all and in the interest of accurate programming, PLEASE COMPLY WITH THESE LIMITS. Should time limits be exceeded, the adjudicator may penalise.

A timer will be used for the Festival.

### **PRIZES**

The adjudicator's decision is final and he/she will have the power to withhold or divide prizes according to merit.

The adjudicator may also be entitled to recommend the awarding of a second prize only, if the performance has not sufficient merit to carry first prize.

## **PROTESTS**

Protests need to be lodged with the CONVENER, in writing, within one hour after the completion of the relevant section and must be accompanied by a deposit of \$10.00, which shall be forfeited if the protest is deemed to be unfounded.

The DECISION of the Committee in ALL questions arising out of, or not provided for by these regulations, shall be FINAL.

'Lack of knowledge' regarding Regulations will not be accepted as a bona fide reason for infringement of any regulation.

ALL competitors compete entirely at their OWN RISK.

## **PHOTOGRAPHY**

Flash photography is not allowed.

Photography is NOT allowed in the Dressing Rooms. The Committee has the right to remove any person who contravenes this direction.

## **PETS**

Animals are not permitted in the Auditorium, except for assistance animals

## **PRAMS AND STROLLERS**

PRAMS and STROLLERS are NOT permitted backstage, on the stairwells, or in the dressing rooms.

## **UNCLAIMED ITEMS / PROPERTY**

Lost property will be kept for 2 weeks and then given to charity.

Unclaimed Adjudicator's Reports and Music CDs will be kept until the completion of the Festival.

## **UNAUTHORISED PERSONS**

Unauthorised persons are not permitted backstage, nor in the Announcer's area.

## **EFTPOS**

EFTPOS is available at the auditorium.

## **AUDITORIUM:**

Murwillumbah Civic and Cultural Centre

STAGE: Approximately 11m wide X 8m deep

## **IMPORTANT NOTICE TO TEACHERS AND PARENTS:**

Please note that once the Speech & Drama Programme has gone to print, no alterations or additions will be made, unless Committee error. Any changes on the day of performance are at the discretion of the Convenor.

## **SPEECH AND DRAMA REGULATIONS**

### **AGE**

Age for competitors is the ACTUAL AGE at the 1<sup>st</sup> January 2026

### **COMPETITORS**

Competitors, please mark your name off at the front desk prior to your session.

Copies of all 'Own Choice' material to be submitted via email to [mfpa.speech1923@gmail.com](mailto:mfpa.speech1923@gmail.com) or to the front desk prior to each session

Please clearly mark **SECTION NUMBER** and **COMPETITOR NUMBER** in the **TOP RIGHT HAND CORNER**. Unless otherwise stated, all pieces are to be performed from **MEMORY**.

### **GUIDELINES FOR MATERIAL**

The selection must be of suitable length and difficulty for each age group.

In choosing your selections, consideration should be given to the appropriateness of the material to the age and experience of the entrant and the boundaries of good taste. Please consider your audience.

### **TIME LIMITS**

Time limits are maximum times – selections may be shorter.

### **COSTUMES AND PROPS**

Costumes are required for Drama Sections, including Shakespeare.

Costumes are optional for 6 Years & Under and 7 Years & Under in all sections. Please keep props to a minimum and ensure they are capable of being handled by the Stage Hands.

### **NOVICE HUMOROUS SECTIONS**

Novice Humorous Sections are for competitors who have never received a 1<sup>st</sup>, 2<sup>nd</sup> or 3<sup>rd</sup> place in any Speech & Drama Section of any Eisteddfod or festival to date.

Competitors in NOVICE HUMOROUS may also enter HUMOROUS but they must use a different poem.

### **SIGHT READING AND IMPROVISATIONS**

Sight Readings and Improvisations will be provided by the Adjudicator. 8 Years to 12 Years = approximately 12 lines

13 Years to 15 Years = half page text

### **VERSE SPEAKING**

Verse Speaking is to be NON humorous

### **DRAMA**

Dramatisation from a Published or Devised piece assuming language, movement and dress of original character. Portray one character only.

### **PROSE**

Prose is an extract from a story. Unless otherwise stated, prose is to be memorised.

The selection may include narration, description and dialogue. It should be spoken in the story-telling style but should not be performed as a dramatic scene. Vocal characterisation is encouraged but the quality of prose must be maintained.

## **MIME**

Mime costume, all black, to be worn. No music allowed.

## **POEMS IN PAIRS**

A poem recited by 2 people. Some **unison** work is required.

## **GROUP DRAMA / POEM / MIME**

Minimum of 3 performers, maximum of 10 performers in all age groups.

## **SPLIT / COMBINED SECTIONS**

Sections may be SPLIT or COMBINED at the discretion of the Convenor.

## **AGE CHAMPIONSHIPS – (Note: - Not the J.J. Richards \$600.00 Scholarship)**

Competitors aged 8 to 14 years must enter the following four sections to qualify for the J.J. Richards Age Championships.

**Verse Speaking, Prose, Drama, Mime.**

7 years: \$30.00 plus Trophy Runner Up: \$20.00

8 Years: \$30.00 plus Trophy Runner Up: \$20.00

9 Years: \$30.00 plus Trophy Runner Up: \$20.00

10 Years: \$30.00 plus Trophy Runner Up: \$20.00

11 Years: \$30.00 plus Trophy Runner Up: \$20.00

12 Years: \$30.00 plus Trophy Runner Up: \$20.00

13 Years: \$30.00 plus Trophy Runner Up: \$20.00

14 Years: \$50.00 plus Trophy Runner Up: \$30.00

15 -17 years: To qualify for the Murwillumbah Central Rotary Scholarship of \$300.00 (first place) and \$200.00 (second place) competitors must enter the following six sections:

**Verse Speaking, PREPARED Prose (not memorised), Drama, Mime, Humorous Verse, and Sight Reading.**
